APRIL BY THE NUMBERS

In April, the Henry County Food Pantry continued its mission of meeting critical needs in our community. Through our food distribution program, we supported 768 households and 1,857 individuals, delivering 934 food boxes filled with nutritious items and hope. Meanwhile, our Clothes Closet served 875 individuals, distributing an incredible 7,526 items—from clothing to hygiene and household essentials. Every number represents a person whose day was made easier because of the support of our donors, partners, and volunteers. Thank you for making this work possible.
