
QUARTER AUCTION

NEIGHBORS RETURNING VISITS IN THE LAST 12 MONTHS

THE GRAPH SHOWS NEARLY HALF (49.3%) OF FAMILIES VISITED OUR PANTRY ONLY ONCE IN 12 MONTHS, THIS SUGGESTS MANY ARE FACING TEMPORARY CRISIS THAT REQUIRE IMMEDIATE ASSISTANCE. THIS DATA REVEALS A LANDSCAPE WHERE VARIOUS LEVELS OF ASSISTANCE ARE NEEDED, REINFORCING OUR COMMITMENT TO SERVING BOTH IMMEDIATE AND ONGOING NEEDS IN OUR COMMUNITY.

HELENE RELIEF BEGINS

In the wake of Hurricane Helene, our team quickly mobilized to provide essential support. Two volunteers drove down to Asheville, NC, with a full truck of donations delivering to ABCCM much needed supplies donated from EMI Recycling, Henry County Food Pantry and Disaster Relief . Recognizing the critical communication challenges faced by first responders, Starlink devices were provided by EMI Recycling to restore connectivity in the region through their Wi-Fi satellite service.

These devices were instrumental in allowing families affected by the hurricane to communicate with their loved ones after being unable to reach out for five days. This initiative was also vital in ensuring that first responders could effectively coordinate their efforts while helping families reassure their loved ones of their safety. We are proud to stand with our community during this challenging time and will continue to support relief efforts as they unfold.



CAREPORTAL HELP TO FOSTER MOM

In September, we had the privilege of supporting four foster moms who unexpectedly welcomed foster children into their homes with limited resources to provide for their needs. Thanks to your generous donations, we were able to supply these families with vital items such as baby diapers, wipes, car seats, food, and clothing to help them through this critical time.
