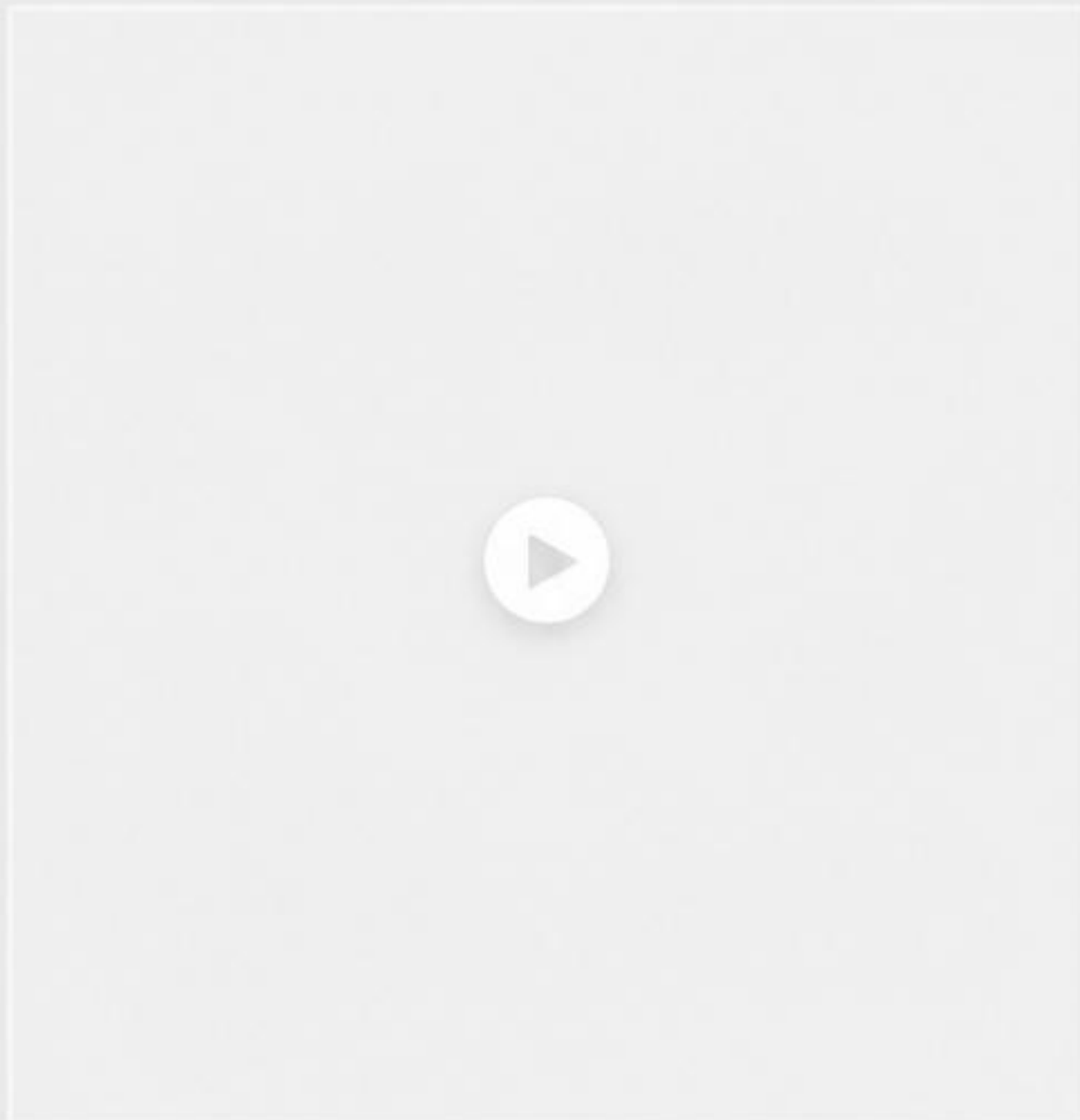


# Impact Report April 2026

In April alone, the Henry County Food Pantry's Bedtime Blessings program delivered 7 beds in a single week, along with responding to several additional requests from families in need. The need continues to grow, and after such a high-demand month, our inventory and available funds are now extremely low.

Every request we receive comes through trusted referrals such as schools, DSS, first responders, and community partners, representing children in our area who do not currently have a bed of their own. Because of the incredible support from our community, we have been able to help many families, but there are still children waiting for comfort, stability, and a safe place to sleep.
