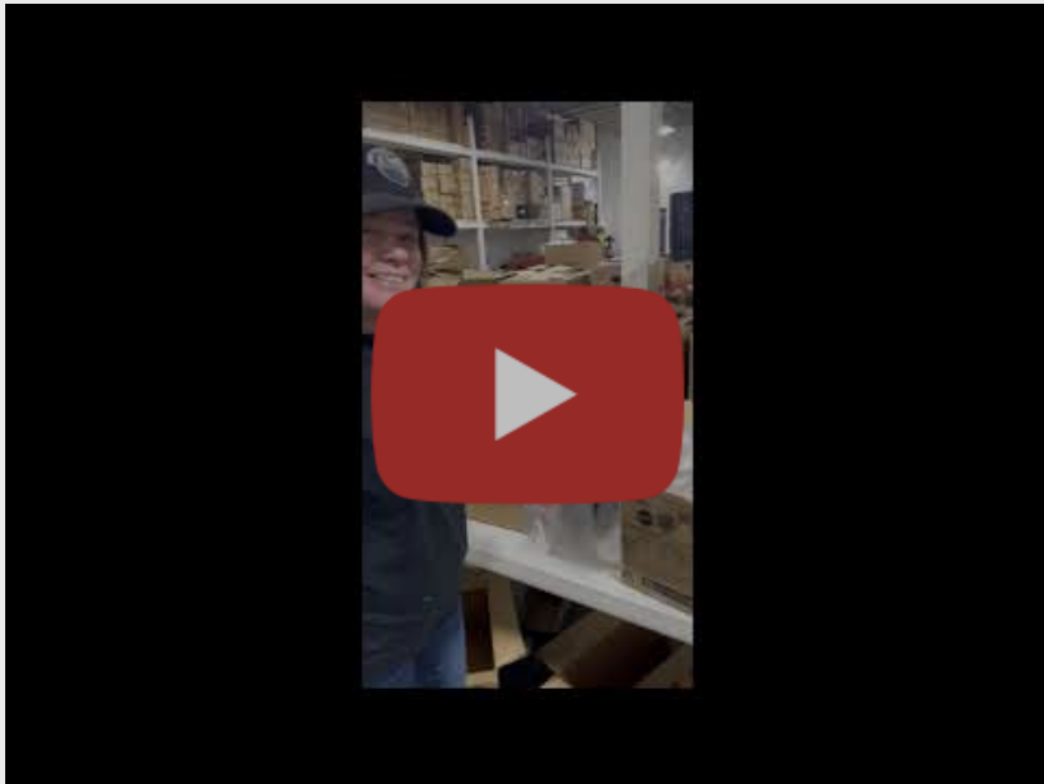


# Emergency Winter Storm Distribution



In response to the recent winter storm, the Henry County Food Pantry quickly organized an emergency food distribution to support our community during a critical time. On that Friday alone, we served 940 individuals, including 361 neighbors accessing our services for the first time.
